1. disagreement between people.

synonyms: strife, conflict, friction, hostility; disagreement, lack of agreement, dissension, dispute, difference of opinion, discordance, disunity, division, incompatibility, variance; antagonism, antipathy, enmity, opposition, bad feeling, ill feeling, bad blood, argument, quarrelling, squabbling, bickering, wrangling, feuding, contention, clashing, falling-out, war, vendetta; *archaic* jar; *rare* disaccord

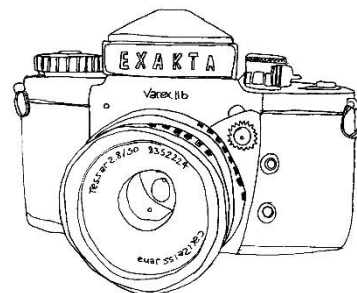
Learning Intentions:

3. To discover photographers and artists who use Discord elements in their own practice

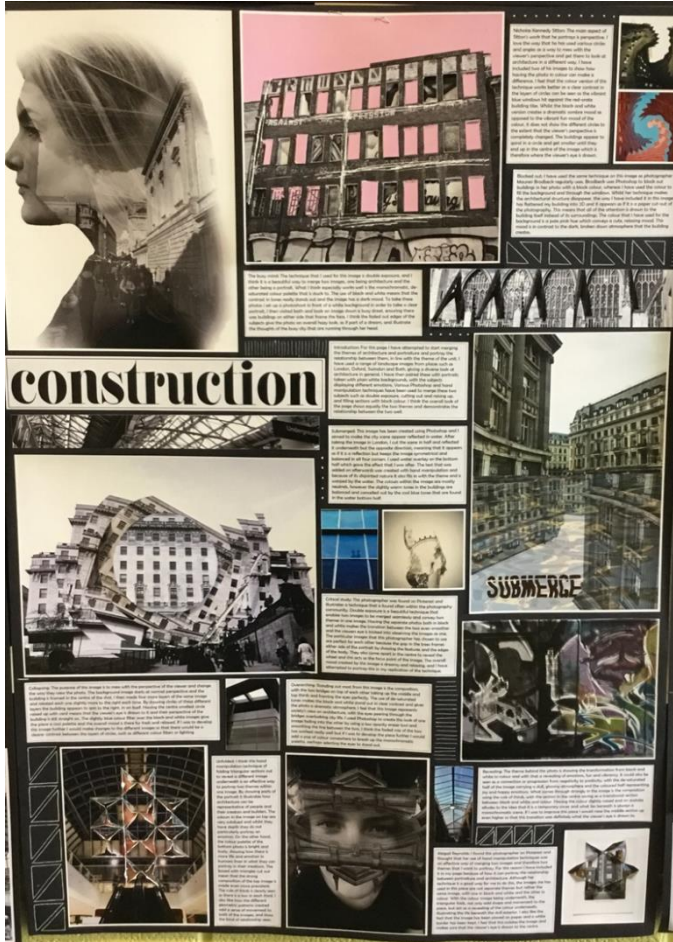
Success Criteria:
